INTRODUCTION

Though Jesus was a devout Jew who practiced His faith, He was criticized for eating with tax collectors and sinners—the religiously nonobservant. Jesus criticizes the selfrighteous and reminds us that mercy is to be at the heart of our religious practices. God continues to be made known in those on the margins of society, like Matthew the tax collector and the hemorrhaging woman. As we gather each Lord's day we receive the healing that makes us well and sends us forth to be signs of God's mercy for the world.

COMMEMORATION

Barnabas, Apostle - Barnabas was not numbered among the twelve



apostles, but the book of Acts gives him that title. After Paul was converted to Christianity, Barnabas welcomed him to Jerusalem, and later the two traveled together on missionary journeys.



WELCOME AND MEDITATION

CALL TO WORSHIPPsalm 33:1-5 (congregation: indented) Sing joyfully to the LORD, you righteous; it is fitting for the upright to praise Him. Praise the LORD with the harp; make music to Him on the ten-stringed lyre. Sing to Him a new song; play skillfully, and shout for joy. For the word of the LORD is right and true; He is faithful in all He does. The LORD loves righteousness and justice;

the earth is full of His unfailing love.
