readings and pray. You may pray: God of grace, You have given us minds to



#### INTRODUCTION

We see sibling rivalry again among the sons of Jacob. Joseph, his father's favorite, would be sold into slavery by his jealous brothers. Many twists and turns would followed, but Joseph's trust in God did not waver. When



the disciples faced a great storm on the sea, they cried out in fear. Jesus said: "Take heart, it is I; do not be afraid." Amid the storms of life, we gather to seek the calm presence of Christ that soothes our fears. God grants us peace and sends us to be a sign of God's presence to others.

#### **COMMEMORATIONS**

Florence Nightingale (1820–1910); Clara Maass (1876–1901); renewers of society - When Florence Nightingale decided she would be a nurse, her family was horrified. In the early 1800s nursing was done by people with no training and no other way to earn a living. Florence trained at Kaiserswerth, Germany, with a Lutheran order of deaconesses. She returned home and worked to reform hospitals in England. Nightingale led a group of thirty-eight nurses to serve in the Crimean War, where they worked in appalling conditions. She returned to London as a hero and resumed her work there for hospital reform. Clara Maass was born in New Jersey and served as a nurse in the Spanish-American War, where she encountered the horrors of yellow fever. She later responded to a call for subjects in research on yellow fever. During the experiments, which included receiving bites from mosquitoes, she contracted the disease and died. The commemoration of these women invites the church to give thanks for all who practice the arts of healing.


