

#### **Mission Moment Update**

This is an update of Mission Moment given on 7/23/23 at the 10:45 service because they will be most affected. We want everyone to be aware and pray for guidance.

Your input is needed about something we on Council are considering.

We just got the June Treasurer's report and it is not good. As you may remember we made some drastic cuts in the 2023 budget. Using round numbers, the total budget – General & Benevolence – for last year (2022) was \$240,000. We brought that down to \$200,000 for 2023 and if present trends continue our expenses should come in right around there, maybe a couple thousand dollars under budget.

The problem is that giving is not what we expected. At the present rate projected total giving for 2023 will be \$175,000. That's a \$25,000 shortfall. We have to do something about that, either the option I am about to describe to you, or something else.

One option is renting out our facilities for another congregation to use. A congregation is interested in using our facilities. Life in Christ Church (LiCC) is a non-denominational, Pentecostal church in Bethlehem that is rapidly outgrowing their building. I know their pastor, the Rev. Norman Carlisle, quite well. He is part of a group of conservative evangelical pastors from many different denominational and theological backgrounds that I get together with regularly. He's the son-in-law of Eleanor Gunkle. He approached me several months ago about using our facilities. He's open to a wide range of possibilities.

We've discussed this at Council and will be meeting with the LiCC Board of Elders in August to explore options. Please be assured that we are approaching this very cautiously. We need your input particularly about the leading scenario.

LiCC's current Sunday schedule is Sunday School at 9:30 and worship at 10:30. If they are willing to adjust their schedule 15 minutes, we could have joint Sunday School at 9:45, which I think would be a great benefit to us. We could once again offer Sunday School for all ages. One of the difficulties we have in attracting young families with children is that we don't have a lot to offer them. We don't have many children.

This schedule would also mean our 10:45 service and their service would happen at the same time. They would need to use the sanctuary because their attendance is around 150. If we go forward with this, I would advocate for joint worship maybe once a month. So once a month you would worship in here and the church would be full. But other Sundays this service would be in Fellowship Hall.

The Council needs your feedback. Please send us your questions, comments, or concerns by whatever means you prefer: letter, email, phone, text, etc. Thank you. If we think this move is well-advised, we will have a Congregational Vote before moving forward.
