

HOLY COMMUNION JANUARY 8, 2024 BAPTISM OF OUR LORD

WE GATHER IN GOD'S PRESENCE

PRELUDE AND PREPARATION

During the prelude, prepare your heart for worship: read the introduction, peruse the bulletin, find the scripture readings in the pew Bible, and focus your thoughts on the Lord. You may pray: Merciful God, we come to Your table trusting not in our own righteousness, but in Your abundant mercy. Grant us so to eat and drink the body and blood of Your dear Son, that we may live in Him and He in us, now and forever. Amen.

INTRODUCTION

Our re-creation in baptism is an image of the Genesis creation, where the spirit/wind moved over the waters. Mark's gospel and the story in Acts make clear that it is the Spirit's movement that distinguishes Jesus' baptism from John's. The Spirit comes upon us as upon Jesus and the Ephesian disciples, calling us God's beloved children and setting us on Jesus' mission to re-create the world in the image of God's vision of justice and peace.

THANKSGIVING FOR BAPTISM

(= All may make the sign of the cross, the sign marked at baptism.)

- P: Blessed be the Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, one God, Who creates us and forms us, Who redeems us and calls us, Who unites us and sends us.
 C: AMEN.
- P: Joined to Christ in the waters of baptism, we are clothed with God's mercy and forgiveness. Let us acknowledge our need for mercy and give thanks for the gift of baptism.

(Please kneel. Silence is kept for self-examination.)

(Liturgist pours water into font at each mention of water.)

P: We give You thanks, O God, for in the beginning Your voice thundered over the waters and by Your Word You created light and all things, calling forth life in which You took delight.

Through the flood You delivered Noah and his family. Through the sea You led Your people Israel from slavery into freedom. At the river Your Son was baptized by John and anointed with the Holy Spirit. At the font You claim us as Your children, making us heirs of Your promise and servants of all.

C: We praise You for the gift of water that sustains life, and above all we praise You for the gift of new life in Jesus Christ. By the baptism of His death and resurrection, Your Son Jesus has carried us to safety and freedom. The

floods shall not overwhelm us, and the deep shall not swallow us up, for Christ has brought us over to the land of promise.


- P: The Holy Spirit has been poured out; the baptized have been washed in this cleansing water and clothed with Christ; Let us live by the Spirit in God's forgiveness, grace and love.
- C: AMEN.



SMALL CATECHISM READING

- L: Let us confess our faith by reading a portion of Luther's Small Catechism, *Appendix I Evening Devotions:*
- L: When we go to bed in the evening, we should bless ourselves with the sign of the Holy Cross and say:
- C: May the will of God, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit be done! Amen.
- L: Then, kneeling or standing, let us say the creed, pray the Lord's Prayer and pray this little prayer as well:
- C: My Heavenly Father, I thank You, through Jesus Christ, Your beloved Son, that You have graciously protected me today. Forgive, I pray, all my sins and the evil I have done. Protect me, by Your grace, tonight. I put myself in Your care, body and soul and all that I have. Let Your Holy Spirit and the angels be with me, so that the evil enemy will not gain power over me. Amen.
- L: After this, go to sleep immediately with joy.

(Response: L: Lord, in Your mercy, C: Hear our prayer.)



THE GREAT THANKSGIVING (Please rise.)

- P: The LORD be with you. C: And also with you.
- P: Lift up your hearts. C: We lift them to the LORD.
- P: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
- **C:** It is right to give our thanks and praise.
- P: It is indeed right and salutary that we should at all times and in all places offer thanks and praise to You, O Lord, holy Father, through Christ our Lord. Sharing our life, He lived among us to reveal Your glory and love, that our darkness should give way to His own brilliant light. And so, with the Church on earth and the hosts of heaven, we praise Your name and join their unending hymn: $(WOV p \ 36)$



PRAYER AND WORDS OF INSTITUTION

P: Blessed are You, O holy God: You are the Life and Light of all. By Your powerful Word You created all things. Through the prophets You called Your people to be a light to the nations. You sent the Living Word, Jesus, Your Son. He is Your Light, shining in our darkness and revealing to us Your mercy and might.

In the night in which He was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks; broke it, and gave it to His disciples, saying: Take and eat; this is My body, given for you. Do this for the remembrance of Me.

Again, after supper, He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it for all to drink, saying: This cup is the new covenant in My blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this for the remembrance of Me.

Remembering, therefore, His preaching and healing, His dying and rising, and His promise to come again, we await that day when all the universe will rejoice in Your holy and life-giving light. By Your Spirit bless us and this meal, that, refreshed with this heavenly food, we may be light for the world, revealing the brilliance of Your Son. Through Him all glory and honor is Yours, Almighty Father, with the Holy Spirit, in Your holy Church, both now and forever. Amen.


THE LORD'S PRAYER (sung)

All who are baptized and trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior may partake. Please fill out a communication card and put it in the offering plate. We have returned to kneeling for communion by "tables." People who want to minimize contact and maintain greater physical distance can take a pre-filled glass and stand a foot back from the altar rail. For a gluten-free rice wafer (blue-green) say "Rice." Grape juice (white) is in pre-filled glasses. Those not ready to receive communion may come for a blessing.
