Holy Cross Evangelical Lutheran Church Semi-Annual Congregational Meeting November 24, 2024

President Lyn Stryker opened the meeting with prayer. There were 37 members in attendance – a quorum was met.

Agenda: As per our By-Laws, the budget and elections are the only items of business.

Proposed General Fund Budget for 2025:

Lisa Wechsler went over each section of the current fund budget, explaining why there were increases or decreases in the budget. She answered all questions that were asked.

Salaries: The salaries remained the same as last year.

Administration: There were 3 areas of large increases. Payroll fees, supplies and computer service fees. The Administration budget figure is \$9,156.00 – an increase of 12.2 percent. Lisa noted that if we hire a sexton, the fees will increase.

Stewardship: There was an increase of 25 percent in the online giving fees.

Benevolence: Remains the same.

Utilities: This is a 50/50 split. There were 2 increases and 2 decreases.

Church Property: There is a 25 per cent increase in the budget. Most of this is due to the insurance going up by 33 per cent. The trash removal increased by 35 percent.

Worship & Music: There was an increase in the cost of piano maintenance.

Publicity: Remains the same.

Christian Education: There was an increase of 30.36 percent due to replacing materials used for Sunday School.

Social Ministry: Remains the same.

Outreach: There is a 10 per cent increase due to community events such as Fall Family Fest and VBS kits for children that are sent monthly. This fee is split with Christian Education.

Pastor: There is no increase in the Pastor's salary or pension.

The new 2025 General Fund budget is \$172,480.53 which is a 5% increase from last year.

A motion was made by Mike Miller and seconded by Patty Stein to approve the 2025 General Fund budget. Motion carried.

Proposed Benevolence Budget for 2025:

Lisa stated that 2 organizations were eliminated that we previously supported due to them not getting back to us with how they were using the funds that we sent to them.

NALC and Lutheran Core were moved to the Benevolence budget under Denominational Outreach.

Overall, the 2025 Benevolence budget went down by 4.69 percent.

A motion was made by Mike Miller and seconded by Jonah Kincaid to approve the 2025 Benevolence budget. Motion carried.

Election of Members to Church Council:
